SPARE DENTURE TO THE RESCUE
Any denture wearer worries about going in public without them due to damage or loss. This is understandable - but preventable. If you wear dentures and care about your ability to eat or appearance in public, it makes a lot of sense to always have a spare set handy just in case your number one set breaks or is damaged (or lost in the lake while swimming). Your dentist can have an exact duplicate of your present denture made in a short amount of time and at a very reasonable cost. (Probably for less than half of what your original set cost).
You can take it with you when you travel (just like it makes sense to carry an extra pair of glasses) and carry it conveniently in a small container in your attache case, pocketbook or keep it wherever your imagination dictates. It will also come in handy if your original denture needs repair.
Just think about this: If you have a spare denture, you might not miss a dinner with your dentist. That's a reward - especially if your dentist is paying for dinner.

Area shoppers start slow

Ronald Carr wonders if this is the long-heralded year when the spirit of Christmas buying finally fizzles.

Jim Peterson calls the next few shopping weeks before Christmas "critical."

"I wonder if this is finally the year they have been predicting for the last three years, the year when people won't spend," said Carr, manager of MacAuley's, Inc. at Livonia's Wonderland Mall shopping center. "I think this may be the year. This is the first year I've seen it this bad. This past weekend was very disappointing. The day after Thanksgiving is traditionally a busy day."

Added Westland Center manager Peterson: "For many stores, if Christmas is unsuccessful, the entire year is unsuccessful."

But Carr and Peterson both said they have what most other retailers contacted in a post-Thanksgiving shopping survey also said they have — lots of hope of making it profitably through another Christmas shopping season.

"There's a greater optimism among merchants than there was during the last 15-16 months," Peterson said. "I think we've realized we've reached a point where the economy has taken an upturn. You have to be positive about the way things are going."

Some, such as Jon Maston, manager of the Crowley's store at Livonia Mall and Mickey Esqueda, owner of Wonderland Mall's Cedar Chest, had good reason for their optimism.

Maston said the number of shoppers in his store the three days after Thanksgiving was "maybe better than last year." Esqueda said she had tripled her sales from the same three-day weekend last year.

Others said they expected the worst and wound up pleasantly surprised. "It was rather encouraging," said Paige Vinegar, manager of Corey's Jewelry Box at the Livonia Mall. "I thought it might be worse. It was so-so, but nice. But I do think customers are more negative than usual. The whole country's negative and they're afraid to buy. It's a feeling that's hard to overcome."

Still others, however, had some bad news to face as they looked at their post-Thanksgiving figures: less traffic, less sales and fewer coins in the till.

"To be honest, we're down," said Charles Manning, manager of Kresge's in the Seven Grand Shopping Center, Seven Mile and Grand River. "I don't know by how much, but there was less traffic in our store, and among those who came in, there were less purchases."

Almost identical words were spoken by a clerk at the Seven-Grand Gift Shop also in the Redford shopping center. "We had lots of customers in here on Friday, but they weren't buying," she said. "I'd say business in the whole (shopping) center is down."

Friday, the day after Thanksgiving, was also a poor sales day for Barbara Cotter, manager of the Winkelman's store at Seven-Grand. "Friday didn't come through for us," Cotter said. "Shopping started out slow in the morning, probably because of the snow, then

peaked in the afternoon. The evening bottomed out. Saturday we were busier than Friday, which is just the reverse of the usual day-after-Thanksgiving trend."

At the Sims Mens and Boys Wear store, also at Seven-Grand, manager Robert Heuser called Friday a "decent" shopping day.

"I'd say we had about 80-90 percent of our normal volume," Heuser said. "So that's not so bad. Friday was decent, and the customers were out buying."

The managers interviewed all said they were trying to give customers what they wanted most this year: good values on practical items and lots of sales and special promotions. "Everybody loves a bargain," Heuser said.

Crowley's Maston described this year's customer as one who has money, but "maybe not quite as much" as in previous years. "This forces us to have a keener awareness of the mood of our customers and maybe show more concern here," he said.

Vinegar, at Corey's Jewelry Box, predicted retailers will have to fight harder for sales this year. "People are watching what they will spend and we will have to fight for and work for every dollar we get," she said.

In MacAuley's, Carr said customers were paying more with cash and less with credit cards.

"Usually, they buy on credit at Christmas," he said. "This year, they're spending only what they have."

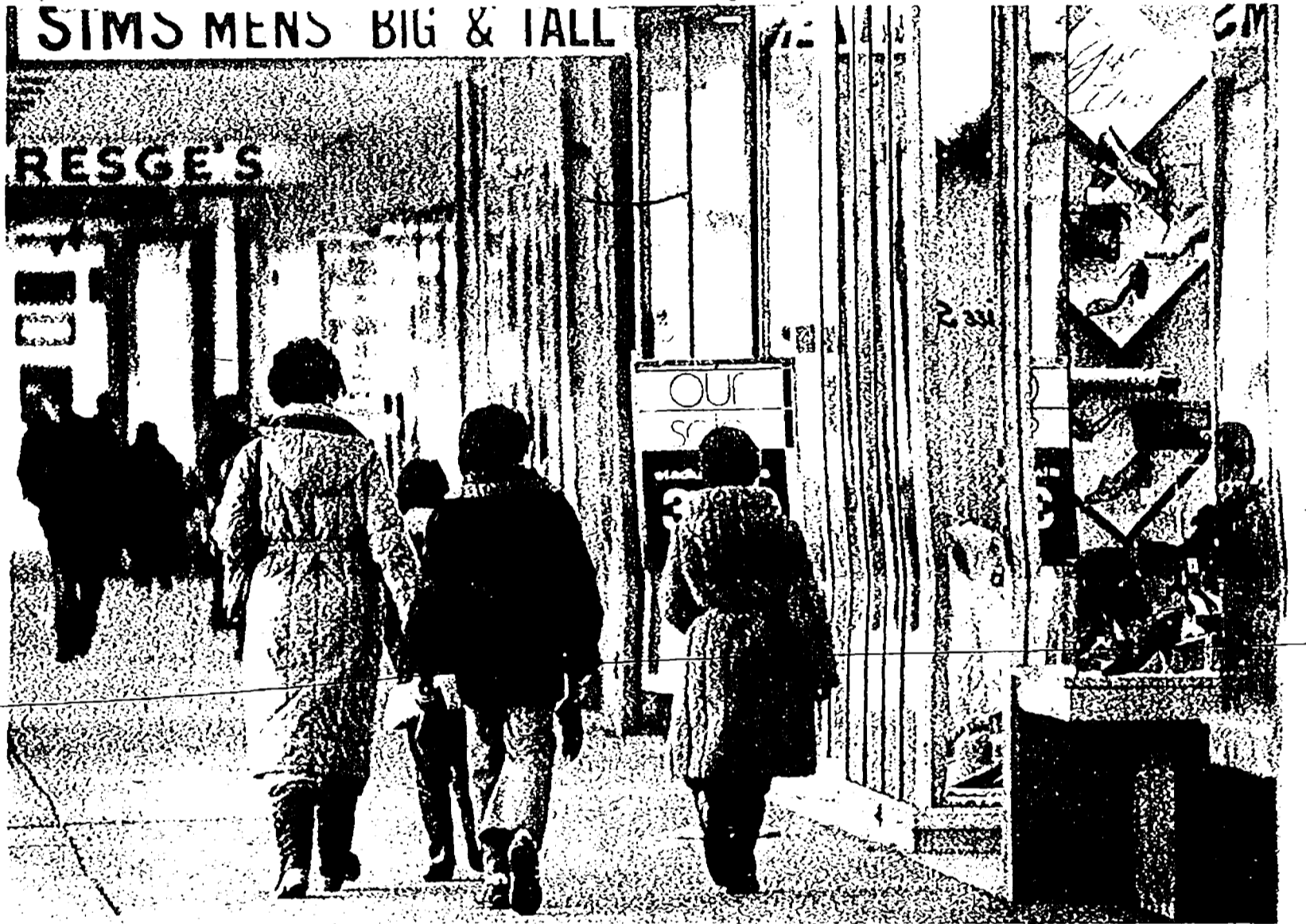

Pryor, Gleason bring out laughs from weak script

Jack Brown, an unemployed journalist, never suspected as he looked for work that he would end up as Jack in the Box. That's what happens to him, though, in "The Toy" (PG).

In this slapstick comedy, Richard Pryor (Jack) ends up a plaything for a millionaire's son. When young Eric Bates (Scott Schwartz), also known as Master Bates, is taken on a tour of his father's department store and told he can pick any present he wants, he points to Jack and announces, he'll take "the black man."

The accompanying executives argue that you can't buy a person. They think it's against the law, but they're not sure. However, Master Bates' wishes are his father's commands. Therefore, his father, U.S. Bates (Jackie Gleason), makes an offer Jack can't refuse — \$3,000 for one week with Eric. (Bates is divorced and only has Eric for one week a year.)

After a few minutes of Eric, everyone can agree with Jack that the divorce settlement was harsh, one week is too long.

BATES IS A TYRANT who rules a business empire that includes a newspaper and factories as well as the department store. If he tells an employee to shave off his mustache or drop his pants in public, the employee does it or the next thing that will be dropped is his name from the payroll.

Within this domain, Bates, who is on a first-name basis with the Grand Dragon of the Ku Klux Klan, doesn't employ any blacks, except in menial jobs.

You can see that the situation calls for drastic changes, and Richard Pryor as Jack is just the man to initiate them. Jack affects their lives by burrowing from within. First he teaches the spoiled, bratty son a couple of lessons about human relationships, and eventually, he gets through to the father.

Is this movie funny? Not as funny as it could be because Brown's potential for disrupting the establishment is never fully exploited.

The movie works best in the first 30 minutes when the emphasis is on Pryor playing poker for discount coupons and food stamps with other unemployed workers; arguing with his girlfriend who works for "Klan Watch," a legal aid society for the poor; getting a job as a "cleaning lady," and facing the stress and humiliations of being unemployed.

THE HUMOR IN THESE scenes has a bright, original spark with real substance behind the clowning and pratfalls. When the emphasis shifts to Pryor as Jack Brown, Eric's toy, the comedy takes a decided downturn. The movie then becomes nothing more than a series of practical jokes, physical comedy children will probably enjoy but which lacks the punch of earlier scenes.

The incidents are completely predictable: a bucket of goop poured on someone's head, a tablecloth laden with plates of food pulled to the floor and the mandatory chase scene. In "The Toy," Brown and Eric destroy U.S. Bates' lawn party as they ride electric carts among the tents and tables, knocking down everything in sight.

There is no faulting Pryor or the other actors in "The Toy." They all did a terrific job. I just wish they could have worked with better material.

HOLIDAY COOKIE HOUSE

Even if you're not a crafts expert, you can build this cookie house. Just follow the step-by-step directions to make a charming holiday decoration you will be proud to display.

The materials and methods you use for this project make it simpler and more economical than most cookie houses. The base is a cardboard box, covered with decorator frosting, so you do not need to work with large, fragile cookies.

Using the refrigerated ready-to-slice cookie dough saves you the time and effort of mixing and rolling batches of cookies. The refrigerated dough makes especially attractive cookies for the house, because it bakes to even-sized, light golden brown cookies. Two rolls of dough will complete the entire project.

The roof shingles are formed simply by slicing the refrigerated dough and sprinkling the unbaked cookies with colored sugar. To make the smaller wall "bricks" you cut each slice of dough into four pieces.

No cookie cutters are required for the decorated holiday shapes that trim the front of the house. Directions are given for forming the shapes by cutting and arranging pieces of dough.

The decorator frosting covers the walls and roof of the house and also acts as "glue" for the cookies. Make three separate batches of frosting, following recipe directions, for ease in mixing.

The cookies should be completely cooled before you work with them, so you can do the baking a day ahead. If you'd rather complete the cookie house in one half-day session, start by baking the cookies. While they are cooling, you can construct the cardboard base, then finish building the house.

To create an attractive holiday scene, display the finished house with miniature evergreens and Christmas figures, such as carolers or angels.

Cookie houses like this have been kept from one season to the next, with just a little patching necessary the second year. The house should be placed in a cardboard box and stored in a cool, dry place.

HOLIDAY COOKIE HOUSE

MATERIALS NEEDED:

2 (17-oz.) rolls Pillsbury Slice 'n Bake Refrigerated Sugar Cookies
Red tinted sugar
Decorator Frosting (see recipe)
Pastry tube and tips
Cardboard box with flaps (approximately 9x12x9-inch)
Heavy cardboard for roof (approximately 14x15-inch)
Masking tape

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

To Bake the Cookies:

For easier cutting and shaping, work with part of the dough at a time and refrigerate the rest until needed. Slice cookie dough as directed. Shape cookies on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake at 325°F. for 8 to 10 minutes or until light golden brown around edges. (Do not overbake.) Cool completely on wire rack before decorating.

1. For Roof Shingles:

Slice one roll of the cookie dough into 50 slices (less than 1/4-inch thick); sprinkle each with red sugar. Bake and cool as directed.

2. For Wall Bricks:

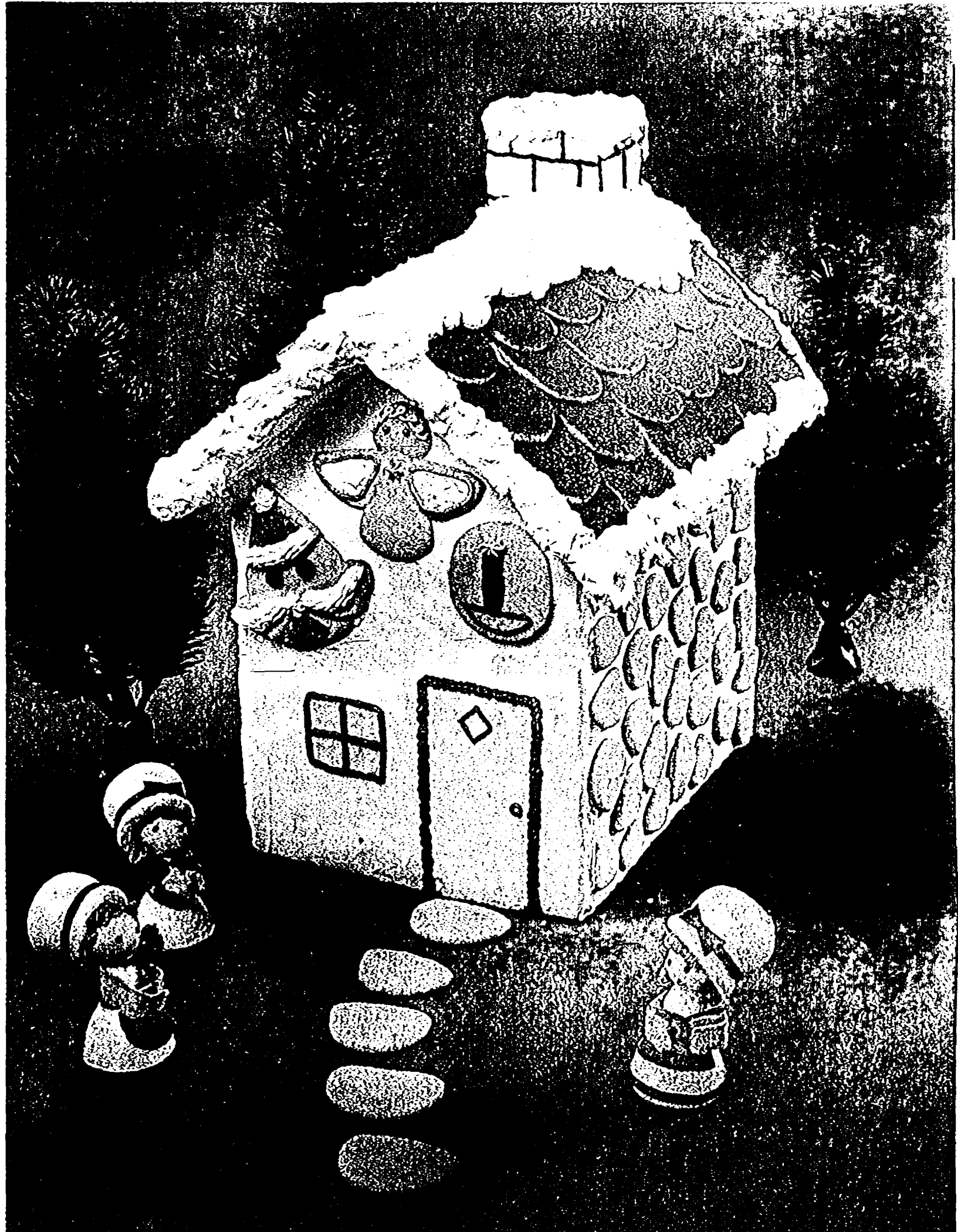
Slice 28 (1/4-inch) slices from second roll of cookie dough. (Refrigerate rest of dough.) Cut each slice into 4 pieces. Bake and cool as directed.

3. For Front Of House Decorations:

Slice remaining cookie dough into 1/4-inch slices and follow directions for making Holiday Shapes.

TO MAKE THE HOUSE

Cut the two longer flaps from box (reserve one for the chimney and the other for reinforcing). Shape shorter flaps into triangles, cutting from top center of flap to corners of box, to form peak at front and back of house. Reinforce triangles on the inside by taping cardboard over the flap fold. Fold 14 x 15-inch piece of cardboard in half to form roof. Tape securely to house. From reserved flap, form and tape chimney, cutting bottom at same angle as roof. Tape to roof.



TO DECORATE THE HOUSE

1. Prepare decorator frosting according to recipe. (Keep frosting covered as you work.) Spread white frosting over sides of chimney. Using red tinted frosting and small writing tip, pipe on lines to resemble bricks. Spoon white frosting around top of chimney to resemble snow.
2. Spread white frosting over roof. Starting at the bottom, arrange a row of cookie "shingles". Overlap remaining shingles in rows to cover roof. (Carefully press cookies into frosting to secure.)
3. Spread a thick layer of white frosting over sides and back of house. Press cookie "bricks" securely into frosting.
4. Spread white frosting over front of house. Using green tinted frosting and leaf tip, make door. Using blue tinted frosting and small writing tip, make window. Arrange decorated cookies on front. Press into frosting to secure.
5. Spoon remaining white frosting on peak and around edge of roof to resemble snow. (If frosting becomes too stiff, add a few drops of warm water.)

DECORATOR FROSTING

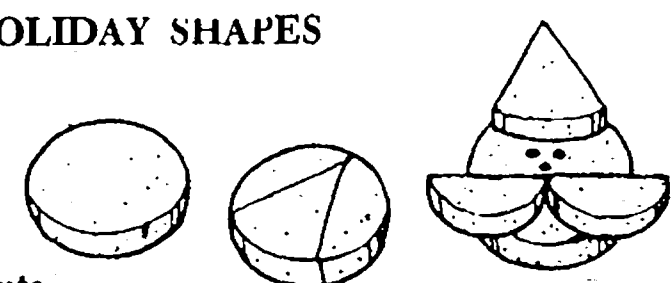
1 cup shortening
4 cups powdered sugar
1/4 cup water

In small bowl, cream shortening until fluffy. Add powdered sugar, 1 cup at a time. Scrape sides and bottom of bowl often to make sure powdered sugar is well blended. Add water slowly; continue beating at highest speed until light and fluffy. 4 cups.

TIPS: For decorating Holiday Cookie House, prepare recipe 3 times. Reserve 2 cups for tinting.

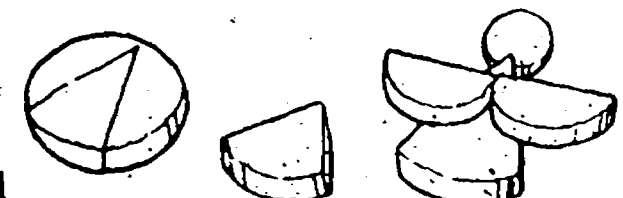
To tint frosting, use 1/3 cup frosting for each color. Tint with food color.

HOLIDAY SHAPES



Santa

- 1) Use 2 slices.
- 2) Cut narrow strip from two sides of one slice, forming a triangle.
- 3) Place triangle over one edge of whole slice for Santa's hat. Use two narrow strips for moustache. Place horizontally on either side of whole slice, inner edges touching and curved edges down. Add chocolate chip eyes and candy mouth.
- 4) Bake and cool as directed.
- 5) Frost hat and moustache with white frosting, using a decorator tip, if desired. Sprinkle hat with red sugar.



Angel

- 1) Use 1-1/4 slices.
- 2) Cut narrow strip from two sides of full slice to form wings and triangular body.
- 3) Place cut-off strips horizontally on either side of top of triangle for wings. Roll 1/4 slice into ball for head. Place at top of triangle; add candy eyes.
- 4) Bake and cool as directed. Outline body and wings with frosting using a decorator writing tip.

Round

- 1) Use 1 slice.
- 2) Bake and cool as directed.
- 3) Using tinted decorator frosting and decorator tips, make candle or desired decoration.

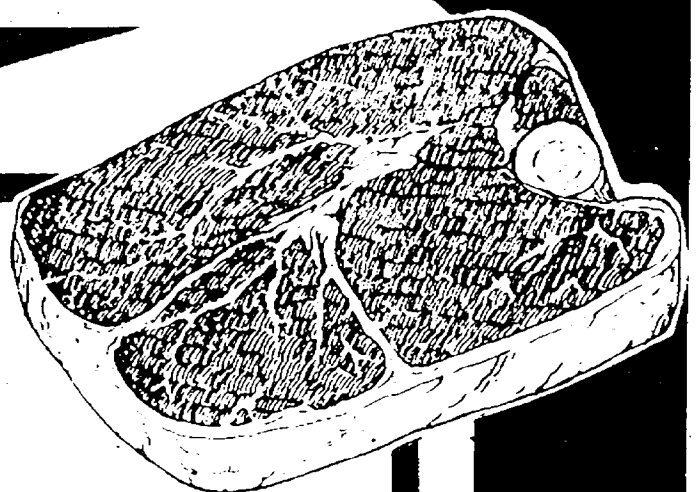

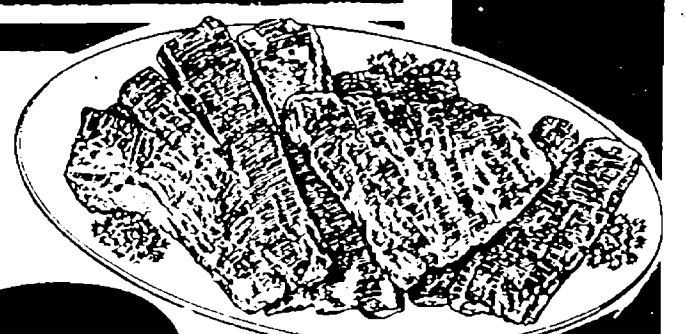

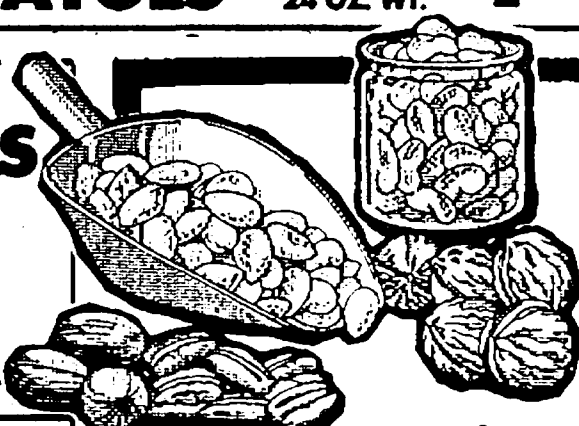

 1 small green pepper, cut into thin strips
 1 tsp. water
 2 tsp. cornstarch
 1/4 cup dry roasted peanuts

Brown pork chops in cooking fat in large frying-pan. Pour off drippings. Sprinkle salt and pepper over chops. Drain pineapple; reserving syrup. Combine mustard and red pepper pods with syrup; pour over pork chops. Cover tightly and cook slowly 45 minutes. Add green pepper and continue cooking, covered, 10 minutes or until chops are tender. Remove pork chops and green pepper to warm platter; keep warm. Combine water and cornstarch, add to cooking liquid and bring to a boil. Boil 1 minute, stirring constantly. Add pineapple chunks and peanuts and heat through; serve with chops. 6 servings.

Rice, garnished with a flower fashioned with cherry tomatoes and parsley, is an attractive accompaniment to serve with Pork Chops Polynesian. For a colorful vegetable, surround green peas with sliced carrots. Mixed greens tossed with avocado slices makes an unusual and tasty salad while citrus ambrosia sprinkled with coconut is sure to be enjoyed for dessert.

He teaches his native 'tongue'

The Madonna College classroom is filled with students, chatting back and forth, waiting for the instructor to arrive. There is a constant level of noise until he enters the room. Then there is silence.

The tall curly-haired instructor smiles broadly at the class, gives a quick wave hello, then raises his index finger to get their attention. He puts his hands together as if in prayer and swiftly opens and closes them. The students understand. He places his hands together again, then begins slowly opening them and holding them there. The students respond, opening their books.

That is how Dennis Berrigan, a deaf instructor at Madonna College in Livonia, begins his sign language studies class. Berrigan, deaf since birth, does not speak and does not use an interpreter to communicate with his hearing pupils. Everything is done in sign language.

AMERICAN SIGN Language (ASL) is Berrigan's native language. In written answers to questions, he said he started signing just before his first birthday. He learned from his parents, who are both deaf. He also has two brothers and a cousin who are deaf.

Berrigan attended St. Mary School for the Deaf in Buffalo and went on to receive a degree from Gallaudet College. He also received a master's degree in education from Western Maryland College.

Before joining the Madonna faculty earlier this year, he was a teacher of the hearing impaired in the Bloomfield Hills School District. It was there he met Ken Rust, chairman of the sign language studies/interpreting department at Madonna.

"Dennis is a natural role model for our students," Rust said. "He is a native user of ASL, has the educational background and the pleasant, supportive personality needed to teach sign language courses."

The way he teaches is the most appropriate, Rust said. "Students would be as proficient in using ASL if they relied on English to learn sign language."

BERRIGAN TEACHES beginning, intermediate and advanced ASL courses. There are 140 hearing students majoring in the SLS/I program. Students can earn an associate's or bachelor's degree, or a one-year certificate of achievement.

In addition to those in the interpreting program, there are more than 50 hearing-impaired and deaf students at the college, studying in a number of areas. They are assisted by interpreters, notetakers and other special aides at no cost to them. Enrollment of deaf students began in 1975 with two.

Madonna College recently was awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Education to establish a regional training center for interpreters for deaf people in Michigan and Ohio. The college also will hold workshops on issues of importance to hearing-impaired people and will assist in upgrading skills of interpreters currently employed.

Berrigan said it is surprisingly easy for him to tell when students don't understand, through their blank facial expressions and lack of feedback. When that happens, he stops and repeats the message until he is sure there is no misunderstanding.

WHAT IS NEEDED to learn ASL? "You have to have a good attitude," said Berrigan "and you have to believe it is a distinct language and also have an understanding of deaf culture, where it is naturally developed and used."

He called Madonna a national leader in the field of education for deaf people.

I'm proud, because a basic goal of the interpreter is to incorporate signs into a comprehensive language, making it possible to communicate with

deaf people, and we are accomplishing that here," he said.

"The administrators, staff and faculty have supported the program and philosophy of sign language studies and interpreting. We have many hearing-impaired persons at Madonna, and our communication rights are respected by all connected with the college."

BERRIGAN MET his wife, Peggy, who is also deaf, at a New Year's Eve party in 1974 at the Buffalo Club for the Deaf. They lived in Southfield.

In high school, Berrigan was named

twice to the Western New York First Team All Catholic basketball squad. He also played four years for Gallaudet College. His basketball career has continued at Madonna, where faculty and staff members occasionally get together for a fast game instead of eating lunch.

After hitting a 20-foot jump shot, Berrigan is greeted by big smiles and "high five" hand slaps, universal communication signs. "Most people don't realize how often in their life they use sign language to communicate," he said.

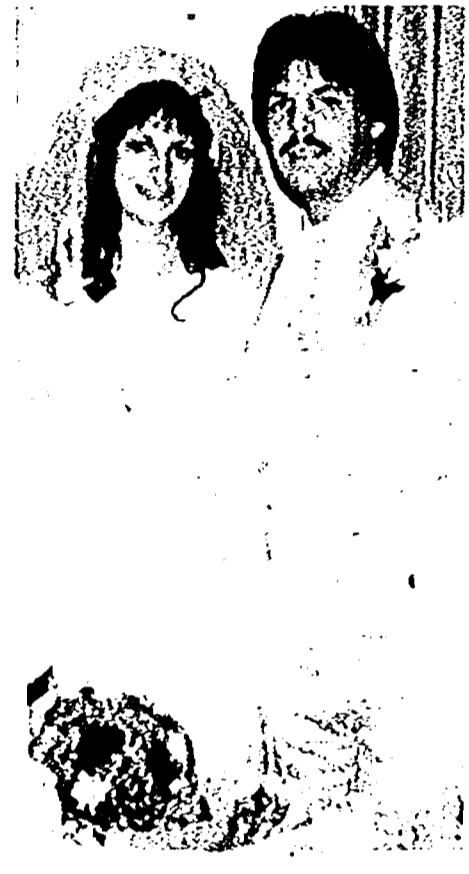

It's going to happen. It's got to. In the very near future — surely within the week — Livonia Ladywood's girls' basketball team is going to have to play an all-out, scramble-for-the-last-shot, down-to-the-wire kind of game.

The Blazers may even have to come from behind.

It's got to happen because Ladywood has added a regional crown to its district title, comfortably subduing Saline Thursday, 75-44, at Chelsea.

The triumph boosted Ladywood into the state Class B quarterfinals Wednesday in Marshall against an opponent that was to be determined Saturday night. And it figures that the eight teams still alive in the playoffs have to be darn good, right?

"Six points was the closest game we've had this year," said Ladywood coach Ed Kavanaugh after his Blazers ran their record to 22-0. "The average score of our games coming into this one was 68-42."

The Ladywood average margin of victory will go up a bit after Thursday's regional win. The difference may have been a change of strategy by Kavanaugh, from the normal run-and-gun Ladywood style to a slower tempo game.

"They (Saline) had to have a transition game," Kavanaugh said. "They like

HOW MUCH OF A difference the switch in strategy made is hard to tell when a team leads by 17 points at half, 24 after three quarters and wins by 31. The Blazers may have won by only 15 or 20 without the change.

And they may not have won at all without Lavetta Willis.

If a player ever thoroughly dominated a game, Willis did in this one. The 5-11 senior positioned herself on the low post and waited for the ball, which got to her sooner or later via the outstanding passing of Ann Lukens, Janine Ceroni and Emily Wagner.

Willis just couldn't be stopped. She had six points in the first quarter, 11 in the second, 10 in the third and four in the fourth to finish with 31 for the game.

Willis received lots of help. Lukens hit consistently from the outside, scoring 16, and Char Govan was on the spot under the offensive boards to gobble up any misses to also finish with 16.

Katherine Arnold paced Saline with 14 points, with Patty Donegan adding nine and Tammy Sabourin eight.

SALINE COACH Elliot Sala was philosophical after the loss. "Everybody expected it to go the way it did but us," he said, insightfully adding, "Maybe it was my imagination, but it seemed they were hitting a lot from the outside. And when your hitting inside and out . . ."

He really didn't have to finish. The scoreboard told all the story that need be told. So did the cheer that erupted from the Ladywood cagers after the victory.

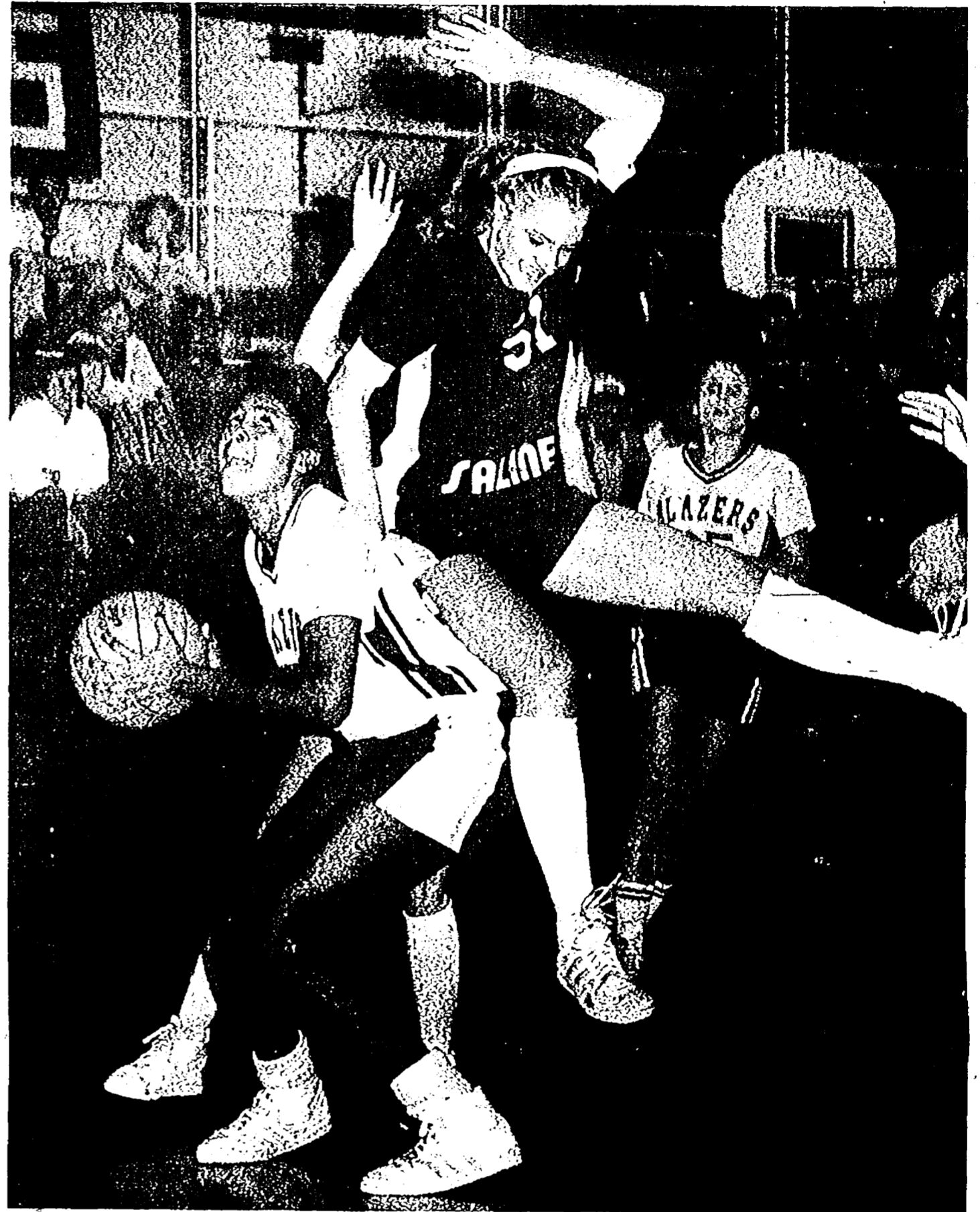
"Three more!" they screamed in unison. Looking ahead to a possible state title?

Schoolcraft cagers big on Briggs

When Schoolcraft College defeated Jordan Community College of Flint, 100-65, last Monday, Carlos Briggs paced the Ocelots with 31 points.

A hot night? No, an off-night for the 6-foot guard. That's how explosive he's been this year as his 45-point average is the main reason the community college is undefeated at 5-0.

Consider his young season. In his first appearance ever for SCC, Briggs found the hoop for 53 points in his team's overtime win over Southwestern College. That broke the junior college state record set by Frank Russell, a former member of the NBA's Chicago Bulls.

BRIGGS FOLLOWED that performance with a 48-point effort against Kellogg Community College at Battle Creek, then left the University of Windsor speechless by pouring in 60 points. Against Jordan he scored his season low of 31 but managed 34 points Thurs-

day when SCC defeated cross-town rival Madonna, 105-60.

That's 226 points in five games. That's also basketball wizardry, said coach Rocky Watkins.

"Oh he's good," said Watkins. "We won't know until Tuesday if he's leading the nation or not in scoring (for junior colleges). But we do know he leading Region 12."

Briggs, a 1981 graduate of Detroit Benedictine High School, first selected El Camino Community College in California to continue his playing days. After two weeks, he returned to Detroit to continue his education and had to sit out his first season while attending Schoolcraft.

THE HOT-HANDED GUARD still has one more year of eligibility left at

the community college, but Watkins is afraid he won't have him around for another season.

"It's quite possible with summer school that Briggs might graduate before the next season," said the Ocelot coach. "He would like to go on and play at a major university."

In the meantime, Schoolcraft is making full use of Briggs' shooting ability. The team is averaging 106 points an outing this season as it rolls past one opponent after another. Against Jordan, the Ocelots used a 17-point effort by George Merriweather, 15 points from Scott Conrad and 11 more from Bill Keyes to turn a 43-36 halftime lead into a 35-point rout.

Schoolcraft had another slow first half against winless Madonna, managing only a 38-24 halftime lead.

"THAT SEEMS to be our profile," said Watkins. "We don't start playing until the second half."

Madonna will testify to that. The team watched a 14-point halftime lead balloon into a 45-point victory as the Ocelots exploded for 67 points in the final half.

Although Briggs had 34 in the win, Keyes, a graduate of Livonia Stevenson, was the outstanding player. The 6-foot-3 forward managed what Watkins coined a "rare triple double" when he scored 14 points, grabbed 16 rebounds and managed 10 assists.

Conrad, a Livonia Churchill graduate, had 12 points, Tom Niergarth scored 11, and Ricky Johnson finished the evening with 10.

Madonna, now 0-4 for the season, was paced by Dave Priebe, who scored 28.
