## Slaying verdict upsets family



A Westland man who admitted clubbing his wife to death could walk free in 60 days, following a jury verdict in Detroit Recorder's Court. The defendant's own brother said Michigan needs to change laws.

Paul Thomas Cramer, who bludgeoned his sleeping wife to death with a baseball bat in their Westland home, was found not guilty Wednesday by a jury that decided he was insane.

"He has gotten away with murder," Cramer's own sister, Rosemary Lance

of Royal Oak, told the Observer.

"Everyone in the family is upset," Cramer's brother, Richard, said. "If he did this once, we truly believe that he can do it again. The trouble with America is that nobody has to be responsible for their actions anymore, and it's wrong. Paul deserves to pay for what he did."

Cramer, 49, will be placed in a psychiatric hospital for a 60-day evaluation, after which time he could walk free.

"It could happen," defense attorney David Esper said.

But Esper said state mental health officials will review Cramer's case after the 60-day period and decide whether he should be placed in a state institution.

"In my opinion he's going to be held," said Esper, who called the Detroit Recorder's Court jury decision "a just verdict."

If placed in a state institution,

Cramer would be evaluated periodically for possible release.

"This is heartbreaking," Lance said. "This man killed the sweetest person who ever walked the face of the Earth."

Paula Cramer, 47, had been married to Paul Cramer for 26 years when she was clubbed three times in the head with a Louisville Slugger baseball bat while she was sleeping in her bedroom. Cramer then drove to the Westland police station, around 2:15 a.m. March 29, and confessed, court testimony revealed.

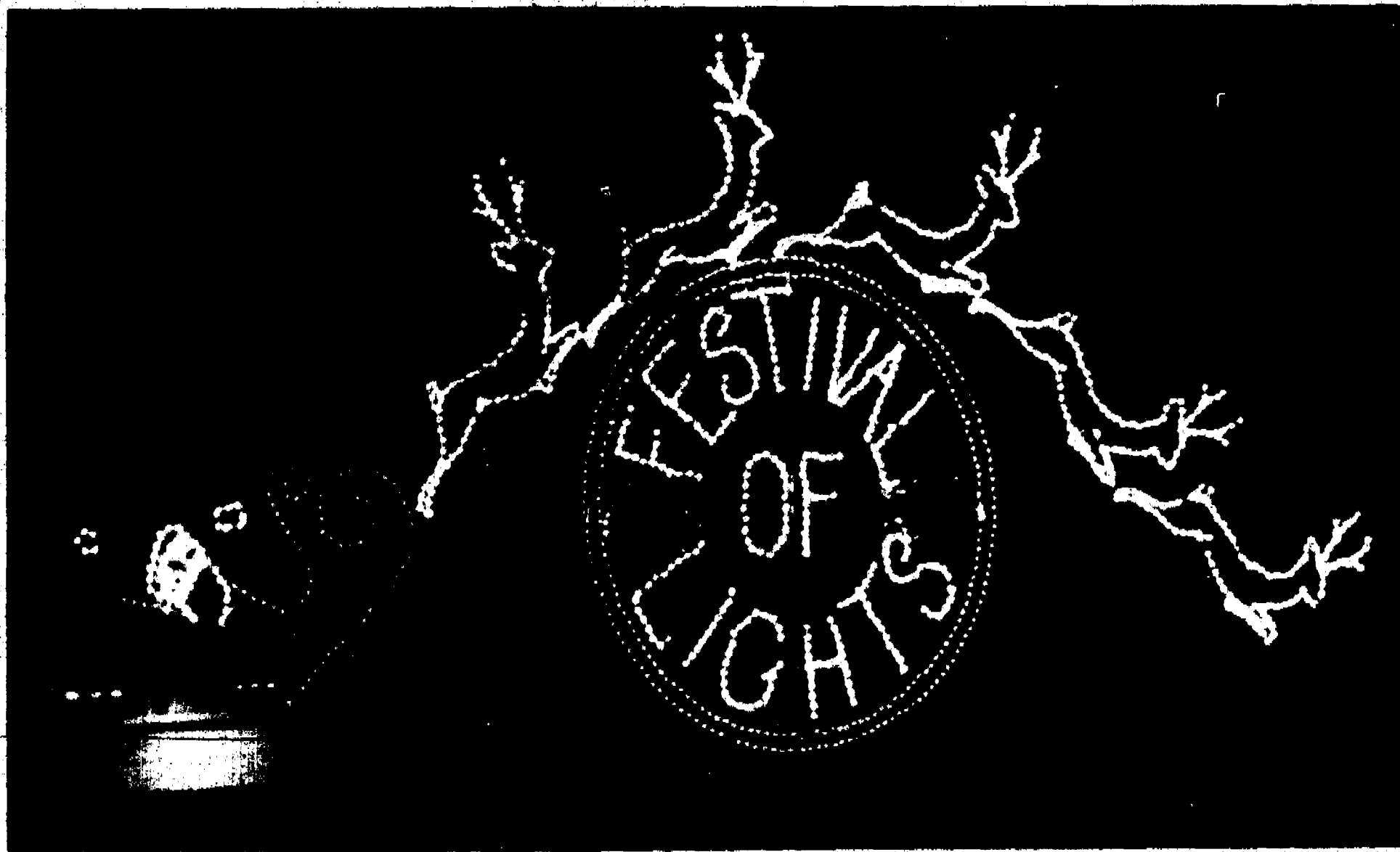

## Man to face trial on felony sex charge

A former Westland girl was only 13 years old when she became pregnant by the man whom she believed was her father, police said.

Now 15, Melissa (not her real name) is living in a foster home in Tennessee with her 20-month-old baby. The man accused of getting her pregnant could spend the rest of his life in prison if convicted of felony sex charges.

Melissa, along with her mother and three younger siblings, lived with Philip Mason, 48, on Dayton Court in Westland when the baby was born, authorities say. Before giving birth,

Melissa wore oversized clothing to hide her condition, her teenage sister said in court Thursday.

Melissa was abused by Mason in other ways, the sister testified.

"He would ask her if she loved him, and when she didn't answer he would slap her," the sister testified.

Melissa was the only child of four who was told that Mason was her father, authorities say. Relatives say they don't know whether Melissa's 34-year-old mother, who had known Mason since she was a teenager, knew better.

The family moved to Wayne and then to Tennessee after Melissa's baby was born. But Wayne police Sgt.

Michael Sumcracki tracked them down, got a court order for blood work, and learned that Mason fathered Melissa's child, assistant Wayne County prosecutor Lora Weingarden said.

"The probability is 99.99 percent," Weingarden said Thursday.

Authorities got involved after relatives and school officials reported suspicious behavior. Melissa and her siblings have been taken from their mother and placed in foster care in Tennessee.

Melissa's mother has a sister who still lives in Westland, but no calls come from from Tennessee. Neither Melissa nor her mother will talk to

the Westland relative.

"I think my sister is still in denial," the Westland relative said. "In their eyes, we're the bad people."

"We couldn't believe this," said the Westland relative, who asked that she only be identified as Melissa's aunt. "My niece would wear the big sweaters, so you never noticed that she was pregnant. If it hadn't been for Detective Sumcracki, Phil would still be with that family."

Instead, Mason sat in Westland 18th District Court on Thursday and listened while Melissa's sister testified against him. The sister, 13

## Taylor man convicted of manslaughter

A Taylor man on trial for killing his girlfriend, stuffing her body in an oil drum and bringing it to a Westland friend's house has been convicted of voluntary manslaughter instead of first-degree murder.

Bret Greenleaf, 34, will face a maximum sentence of 15 years in prison when he is sentenced by Detroit Recorder's Judge Margie Brazton, who announced her verdict Friday following a one-week bench trial.

"The judge thought it (the killing) was the result of an argument and that (Greenleaf) didn't mean to do it," assistant Wayne County prosecu-

tor Daniel Less said.

Greenleaf could have faced life in prison if he had been convicted on the original charge of first-degree murder.

He was charged after he killed Tammy Lynn Davis, 30, by smothering her to death with his hand during a fight at 4:30 a.m. April 18, Less said. Greenleaf then stuffed the body in a 55-gallon oil drum and drove it in his pickup truck to a friend's residence on Caseville Court in Westland, Taylor police Commander Stan Cybert has said.

Greenleaf's friend helped to alert authorities to the incident, and Greenleaf was arrested in Westland, Cybert has said.

Authorities, including Westland police officers,

voiced shock at the verdict, but Less said the judge believed that Davis was killed accidentally during a struggle with Greenleaf.

When asked if consideration was given to the body being stuffed in an oil drum, Less said, "No body seemed to talk much about that."

Greenleaf was taken to the Westland police station after his arrest on April 18, but he was then transported to Annapolis Hospital because of "fainting spells," Westland police Sgt. Tom Kubitkevich said at the time.

It was later determined that Greenleaf suffered an overdose of prescription drugs during an apparent suicide attempt, Cybert said.

## Law will legalize home music teaching

Legislation that would allow music instructors to teach scales, sonatas and solos in their homes without worry is poised for passage in the state Legislature.

The question is whether a lame-duck House of Representatives will consider the bills before the legislative session ends, said Sen. David Honigman, R-West Bloomfield, a sponsor, who expects approval of the three-bill package that permits academic tutoring at home.

"If they meet at all, it's going to pass, and I expect they're going to meet again," said Honigman. The state Senate overwhelmingly approved the bills, which Honigman said have bi-partisan support. But one House aide familiar with the legislation said the chamber was unlikely to take up the

measures this year.

Sen. Jack Faxon, D-Farmington Hills, predicted the package would be passed this year. Faxon has long been a patron of the arts.

"I don't see where there should be any problem with them," Faxon said.

The bills would establish a state law allowing art and music teachers to practice their profession without running afoul of municipal ordinances that regulate home businesses.

The bills were introduced twice before but failed to reach the floors of both houses for votes.

"This is the farthest we've ever gotten," the senator said.

He first introduced the legislation in 1987 after a West Bloomfield Township couple was cited for teaching music in their home.

"We've gotten so many professional musicians out of our

studio, but one of our neighbors decided he wanted to try to stop us," said Betty Kowalsky Stassen, a piano teacher who pushed for state legislation to solve the problem after getting a ticket.

West Bloomfield eventually passed an ordinance that allows home-based music teachers, but some other municipalities haven't, Stassen said. Music teachers still get ticketed.

Stassen, whose home contains two Steinway grand pianos, said she and her husband, Gerald, a violin and strings instructor, now teach about three days a week.

"It's not business, it's education," Stassen said. She argues that music teachers provide a vital service in encouraging and developing talent and a love of the arts.

Passage of the legislation, which the Senate approved in near-unanimous votes last May,

"will make us feel like we're not criminals," said Arvi Sinka, a piano teacher.

"At this moment, in nearly every municipality in the state, teaching music in the home is counter to city codes," said Sinka, a pianist with the Birmingham-Bloomfield Symphony Orchestra.

Honigman said the legislation had received some opposition from municipal associations but that he believed their concerns had been resolved.

If the bills are not passed by the end of December, they would have to be introduced a fourth time, Honigman said.

"As of now, I know of no organized opposition," he said.

He said Republicans, who currently share control of the House with Democrats, may hold off voting on some legislation this year because Republicans will hold a clear majority in the House next year.

# Deck the halls with safety and caution

Detroit Edison is cautioning homeowners to be careful this holiday season when they put up electric decorations.

The most important thing to check before stringing lights and setting up other trimmings is to make sure they contain a label from Underwriters Laboratories, Edison said in a press release.

The second-most important consideration is to use lighting as it is intended by the manufacturer—either outdoor or indoor.

Also, inspect Christmas lights for frayed wires, damaged sockets

and cracked or missing insulation.

Most lights cost 1-7.5 cents per string to operate for six hours, depending on wattage, Edison said. For strands of lights that blink off and on, the cost is halved.

Edison offered the following suggestions for a safer holiday season:

### Indoor lighting

■ Do not overload electrical circuits. Older home circuits usually cannot safely carry more than 15 amps, or 1,800 watts. Newer homes are able to carry as much

as 20 amps or 2,400 watts. For the best results, load to only 80 percent of your home's maximum capacity.

■ Use no more than three sets of standard lights on each extension cord.

■ Do not insert new bulbs or change fuses when light sets are plugged in.

■ Keep lights away from carpeting, furniture and drapes. Some standard lights produce enough heat to scorch or damage items they touch.

■ Turn off decorative lights before you go to bed or leave home.

# State road crews bracing for winter weather

State and county highway maintenance crews are preparing for snow, sleet and freezing rain. "Keeping our state's 9,550-mile highway system clear of ice and snow is our top priority during the winter," said Michigan Department of Transportation spokesman Pat Nowak.

The state government says it will spend nearly \$40 million for snow and other winter maintenance this year, about a third of its annual highway maintenance budget.

M-DOT says it will give the highest priority to plowing heavily traveled highways that average at least 5,000 vehicles a day in volume.

They will be plowed as soon as possible until the pavement is

generally bare of ice and snow.

Lesser traveled highways will be plowed until the center portion of the road is clear or until the pavement is passable.

They will be fully cleared later during normal work hours.

The department maintains state highways in 21 counties and partners with road commissions and public works departments in

the remaining 62 counties and 164 cities.

M-DOT maintenance improvements in the state include increasing the use of permanent raised pavement markers to better delineate lanes for nighttime guidance.

The reflectorized markings, which are on about 76 percent of non-lighted freeways in the state,

show up better than painted lines during wet conditions.

The department also is installing flexible reflector posts in high impact areas, such as freeway ramps.

The posts are constructed of a flexible plastic that bends and rebounds on impact.

Besides improved safety to motorists and less vehicle damage,

they are more cost effective and require little to no maintenance once installed, M-DOT officials say.

Motorists are warned to watch out for ice on bridges.

Cold air passing under the bridge causes the temperature of the bridge deck to drop.

While the adjoining pavement may be dry, condensation forms

on the bridge deck and freezes, making driving treacherous.

Motorists are also cautioned not to follow snow plows closely.

The blizzard-like conditions that typically surround a plow make it difficult to follow closely or pass.

And there's a risk of being hit by rocks, chunks of ice or salt thrown from the plow.

## Fuel prices up for holidays

Motorists will pay nearly a nickel per gallon more to drive this Thanksgiving than they did in 1993, the American Automobile Association reports.

AAA's Fuel Gauge Report shows the nationwide average price of self-service regular unleaded gas rose 4.9 cents to \$1.165 per gallon.

The price is up 0.8 cent from last month.

The cost of self-serve, midgrade unleaded rose 4.6 cents from last Thanksgiving to \$1.261 per gallon.

Self-serve premium unleaded was up 3.6 cents to \$1.341.

Regionally, prices were highest in the West (\$1.28 per gallon) and lowest in the Southeast (\$1.11).

Other prices were: Mid-Atlantic (\$1.18), New England (\$1.18), Southwest (\$1.15), Great Lakes (\$1.13) and Midwest (\$1.13).

Nationally, nearly 64 percent of the stations surveyed will be open on Thanksgiving Day and 54 percent will operate 24 hours.

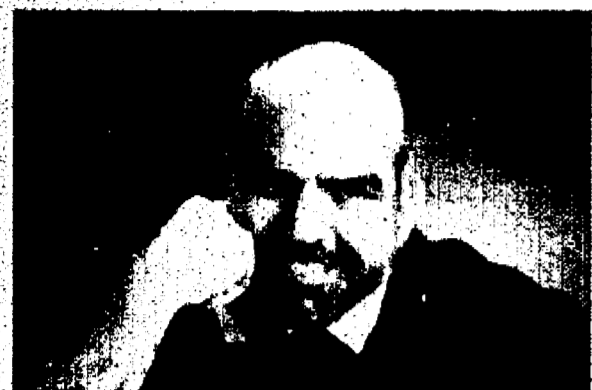

## Relax and plan your great turkey dinner

I'll never forget the first time I cooked Thanksgiving dinner. I didn't have 27 years of cooking experience under my belt, and felt totally overwhelmed.

My heart went out to Sandy from Southfield, who nervously approached me one afternoon at a Kitchen Glamour store.

This is going to be Sandy's first year preparing Thanksgiving dinner for her in-laws, who are coming from upstate New York. Sandy said she knows nothing about cooking a turkey, let alone making an entire dinner.

### This column's for you

If you've never attempted to prepare a full turkey dinner, then this is the column for you. Mothers, clip this out and send it to your kids, or file it until they're old enough to invite you over. You won't be disappointed.

First off Sandy, the best thing you can do is plan ahead. Work out the menu and choose some recipes. Then write your shopping list.

Experience has taught me to write down what needs to be done at what time. If appetizers and desserts can be made a day or two ahead, why not take advantage?

When it comes to buying a turkey, fresh birds are best. Allow one pound of uncooked bird per person, more if you want leftovers. Order your bird today.

Check your spice rack to make sure you have what you need. Ditto for serving pieces, cookware, utensils and cutlery.

### Look for Yukon Golds

Plan on eight ounces (½ pound) of potatoes and vegetables per person. When it comes to potatoes, look for Yukon Golds, they make great mashed, roasted or baked potatoes, and are easy to find at grocery stores.

For convenience, turn fresh or frozen vegetables into casseroles. Definitely do this the day before.

People love stuffing, and it can be as easy or as complicated as you choose to make it. Plan on two cups of stuffing per person and, whatever you do, don't stuff the turkey! Cooking the stuffing separate in a covered casserole shortens the cooking time of the turkey. Homemade breads and rolls are nice, but check out the selections from specialty bakeries in your area. Buy breads and rolls ahead of time, wrap and freeze. Pop them in the oven for 10 minutes while the food is being placed on the table Thanksgiving Day.

Remove the turkey from the refrigerator one hour before roasting begins. As a rule, unstuffed birds require 16 minutes per pound while stuffed birds require 20.

### Make sure it's done

When it comes to cooking the turkey, the most difficult task is deciding when it's cooked. Invest in a good thermometer and cook the bird until the temperature in the thickest part of its thigh, without touching the bone, reaches 165 degrees.

But before you cook the bird, remember to wash the inside and remove the bag containing the giblets, neck, gizzard, etc. Rinse the bird inside and out with cold water. Pat dry with paper towels. Lightly season the turkey inside and out with salt and fresh ground pepper.

You can make a stock with the neck and giblets by placing them in a small saucepan and covering with two cups of water. Bring to a boil, reduce the heat and simmer for 1 hour. If you desire, insert a cut up onion and any fresh herbs like parsley, celery leaves or fresh sage in the cavity and truss, if you know how. If you don't, forget it.

Now it's time to begin cooking. Preheat the oven to 425 degrees. Place the turkey, breast side up, on a greased rack in a shallow roasting pan just large enough to hold the bird. Melt a stick of butter and cut a 14 by 24 inch piece of cheese cloth. Soak the cheesecloth in the melted butter until all butter has been absorbed. Double the cheesecloth and drape it over the turkey breast (this ensures a moist, not overcooked breast).

Place the turkey in the oven and immediately reduce the heat to 325 degrees. Using a large-bulb baster, baste the turkey through the cheesecloth with the pan drippings every 30 minutes. About 45 minutes before the turkey is finished, remove the cheesecloth. Continue roasting and baste every 10 minutes. Check the temperature at this time. When the bird reaches 165 degrees, transfer the turkey to a carving board and cover loosely with foil and allow to rest for 20-25 minutes.

The bird's internal temperature will rise about 10 degrees, and the bird will retain more juices. Make the gravy and mash potatoes.

## Preparing for Hanukkah is 'men's work'

Making potato latkes is a male tradition in the Katzenstein family. Three generations - grandfather, father and son - help prepare food for the eight-day Jewish Festival of Lights.

Most people think of candles, not food, when it comes to Hanukkah. But for some families, food is an important part of this "Festival of the Lights," which is observed over eight nights beginning at sundown, Nov. 27.

According to Danny Katzenstein of Beverly Hills, preparing food for the celebration commemorating the Maccabees' rededication of the Temple in Jerusalem in 165 BC, has become a male tradition in his family.

"My father, father-in-law and I make the potato latkes for our family celebration," Katzenstein said. "This year we're going to introduce my eight-year-old son, Joshua, to this custom."

Grandfather Sonny Schwartz of Farmington Hills said that while Josh is going to be taught "the skill of making not only good, but great, latkes, one tradition - that of cooking with a glass of vodka in one hand - will have to be postponed for a number of years."

Josh's other grandfather, William Katzenstein of Birmingham, said

that the vodka is needed to inspire the chefs.

"It also makes it much easier to handle the less-than-pleasant task of peeling lots and lots of potatoes."

Danny Katzenstein said potato latkes, also known as potato pancakes, are a traditional Hanukkah food because they are cooked in oil.

"Oil is a significant ingredient to Hanukkah. After the Maccabees threw out the Greeks and their idols, they lit a lamp to help them clean up the Temple. There was only enough oil in the lamp to last one night, but a miracle happened. The oil lasted for eight days," he said.

"Cooking food in oil is one way of marking this occasion. Another is lighting the menorah (a candelabrum that holds nine candles). One candle is lit the first night, two the second and one on each of the remaining nights of Hanukkah."

William Katzenstein said that while latkes are the tradition of Jews in this country, deep-fried pastries similar to jelly-filled donuts are the

tradition in Israel.

According to the three chefs, some American Jewish families also make "heinenblozen" for their celebration.

"This is cookie dough that is deep fried in oil. While being fried, the dough expands. The result are odd-shaped puffs that are sweetened with powdered sugar and cinnamon," said Danny Katzenstein.

Sweet treats are not the main concern of Sonny Schwartz. He said his
