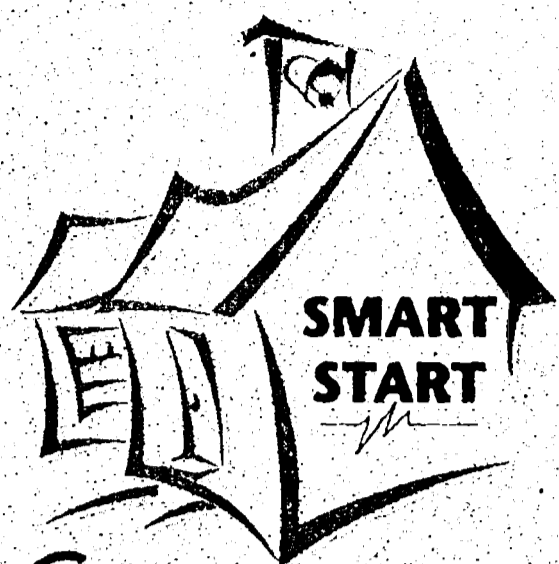

## Mistrial ruling enrages ex-wife



Michael Janik, charged with setting his ex-wife ablaze, won a new trial Thursday in a courtroom ruling that enraged the woman. A judge said the prosecuting attorney went too far in questioning the defendant.

A Detroit Recorder's Court judge declared a mistrial Thursday for a former Westland man accused of setting his ex-wife on fire, prompting an emotional outburst from the distraught woman.

"You can't do that!" screamed Karen Janik, 30, after Judge Bruce Morrow declared a mistrial for Michael Janik, 41, charged with assault with intent to murder and arson.

Standing up in the courtroom, Karen Janik also turned to her ex-husband's family members and lashed out at them.

"Why do you people want him off for?" she asked in tears, questioning why relatives want Michael Janik cleared of charges.

"Go ahead! Let him go! Let him go!" Karen Janik sobbed as authorities led her from the courtroom. "What's wrong with you people?"

Her outburst marked a dramatic ending to the third day of a trial that Morrow has rescheduled for Jan. 8. The new trial will come one year and

six days after Michael Janik, a former Garden City resident, is accused of trying to kill his ex-wife at his 465 S. Hawthorne residence.

Janik, a former Westland and Garden City resident now living in Canton Township, left the courtroom Thursday with family members. He has been free since Feb. 13, when his

family posted \$7,000 of a \$70,000/10 percent bond.

The judge declared a mistrial Thursday after assistant Wayne County prosecutor Jerry Dorsey IV, trying to discredit Michael Janik's testimony from Wednesday, questioned him about statements he may have made to police after the Jan. 2 incident.

### Prosecutor warned

Dorsey had implied in front of a jury that the defendant fabricated a new version to aid in his defense, but Morrow ruled that Dorsey's line of

questioning went too far and may have violated Michael Janik's rights.

There had been nothing on the court record about any prior statements made by Michael Janik, and Morrow's ruling stemmed from concerns that Dorsey exposed jury members to issues they shouldn't have heard.

Dorsey said in court that he wanted to impeach Michael Janik as a witness because of alleged inconsistencies in his statements. Morrow had warned Dorsey to approach the issue delicately.

## Cop admits holding onto evidence

A veteran Canton Township police officer, testifying in his brother-in-law's trial on an attempted murder charge, admitted having potential evidence in his possession that he never turned over to police.

But officer George C. Sharp, under intense questioning from a prosecutor, denied Wednesday that he meant to conceal evidence to protect Michael Janik, who is charged with trying to kill his wife, Karen, by setting her on fire.

Sharp testified that he was given Karen Janik's clothing when he and his wife, Candace, visited her at the University of Michigan Hospital on Jan. 2. That was the same day Karen Janik said her ex-husband doused her with lighter fluid and set her ablaze with a cigarette lighter at their former Westland residence.

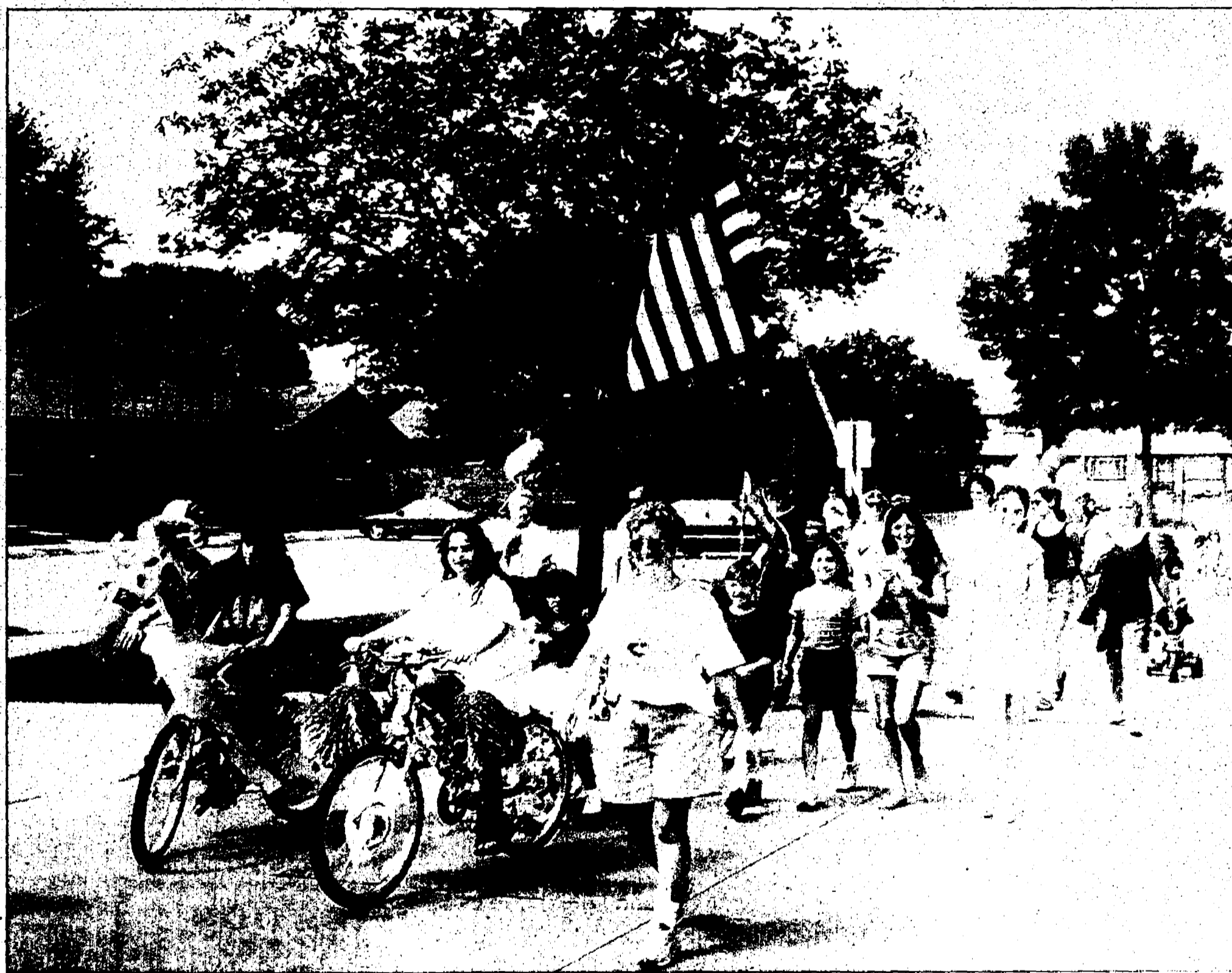
Sharp, an 18-year Canton officer, said he was given Karen Janik's shoes, blue jeans, bra and panties. The shoes were damaged during the fire.

Sharp testified that he kept the clothing until after Michael Janik was arraigned Jan. 10 on charges of arson and assault with intent to murder. He said in court that he didn't think of the clothing as evidence.

When he did turn over the clothing, Sharp said he gave it not to Westland police or Wayne County prosecutors, but to defense attorney W. Otis Culppepper. Culppepper brought the items to court Wednesday.

# Field trip

## New Wayne-Westland teachers get tour of district

Wayne-Westland school bus 89 had a different load of passengers on a special "field trip" Wednesday afternoon.

Driver Sharon Conley bused some 25 passengers on what the "tour director" said would be a snapshot of the sprawling 68-square mile district.

What the passengers, among the 48 new teachers hired by the district this summer, got was a wide-angle mural of the school system.

The bus tour, led by Greg Baracy, assistant superintendent for general administration, and Terry Wood, newly-appointed community relations director, was intended to give the new faculty members a sense of the size of the district, which takes in parts of five municipalities, and a window view of many of the schools.

The new teachers represented the largest number hired by the district since the early 1970s.

The new faculty members are a result of a retirement incentive program of which 160 teachers and 21 administrators took advantage.

Some new teachers didn't take the bus tour because they had subbed in the district for several years and knew the school community.

But others who were familiar with the school system still took the tour and enjoyed it.

One, Laura Messer, said she is excited about her new assignment as an English teacher at John Glenn High and Marshall Middle School.

But she is no stranger to the

district.

For the past eight years, Messer, 47, was an English and art teacher in the district's adult education department.

"I feel dedicated to Wayne-Westland, feel that it's an excellent educational opportunity and offers a lot for students and parents when they want to get involved," Messer said while the bus traveled up and down major roads in Westland, Canton Township and Wayne.

Another passenger, Linda Cox, admitted she is "scared" about starting her new career. She is assigned to a fourth-grade class at Walker Elementary.

Like Messer, Cox isn't the typical 22-year-old fresh out of college.

In her early 40s, Cox was in computer technology for the TRW Company before resigning two years ago to attend school full time and earn her degree and teaching certificate.

But she is no stranger to the district, as she was driven past her former schools, Stevenson Junior High, which she attended when it opened in the fall of 1988, and Wayne Memorial High.

The bus tour also included two small personal touches for directors Baracy and Wood.

While moving south on Howe near Annapolis in the southern half of Wayne, Wood pointed to the frame house in which she grew up. Then Baracy pointed to the residential neighborhood to the east in which he was raised.

During the bus trip, Baracy stressed that the district's southwestern boundary zigzags along Palmer Road all the way to Canton Center Road and all the way east to Inkster and Dearborn Heights.

Providing a brief history of the district, he noted that at its peak 10 years ago after the annexation of the Cherry Hill district, Wayne-Westland had some 24,000 students.

Now it has declined to some 14,700, he said.

That resulted in the closing of numerous school buildings, including four elementaries in June.

Touching on the changing demographics of the district, Baracy said while there are new subdivisions and homes opening at a rapid pace, studies show that there are only .4 of a child in each new home.

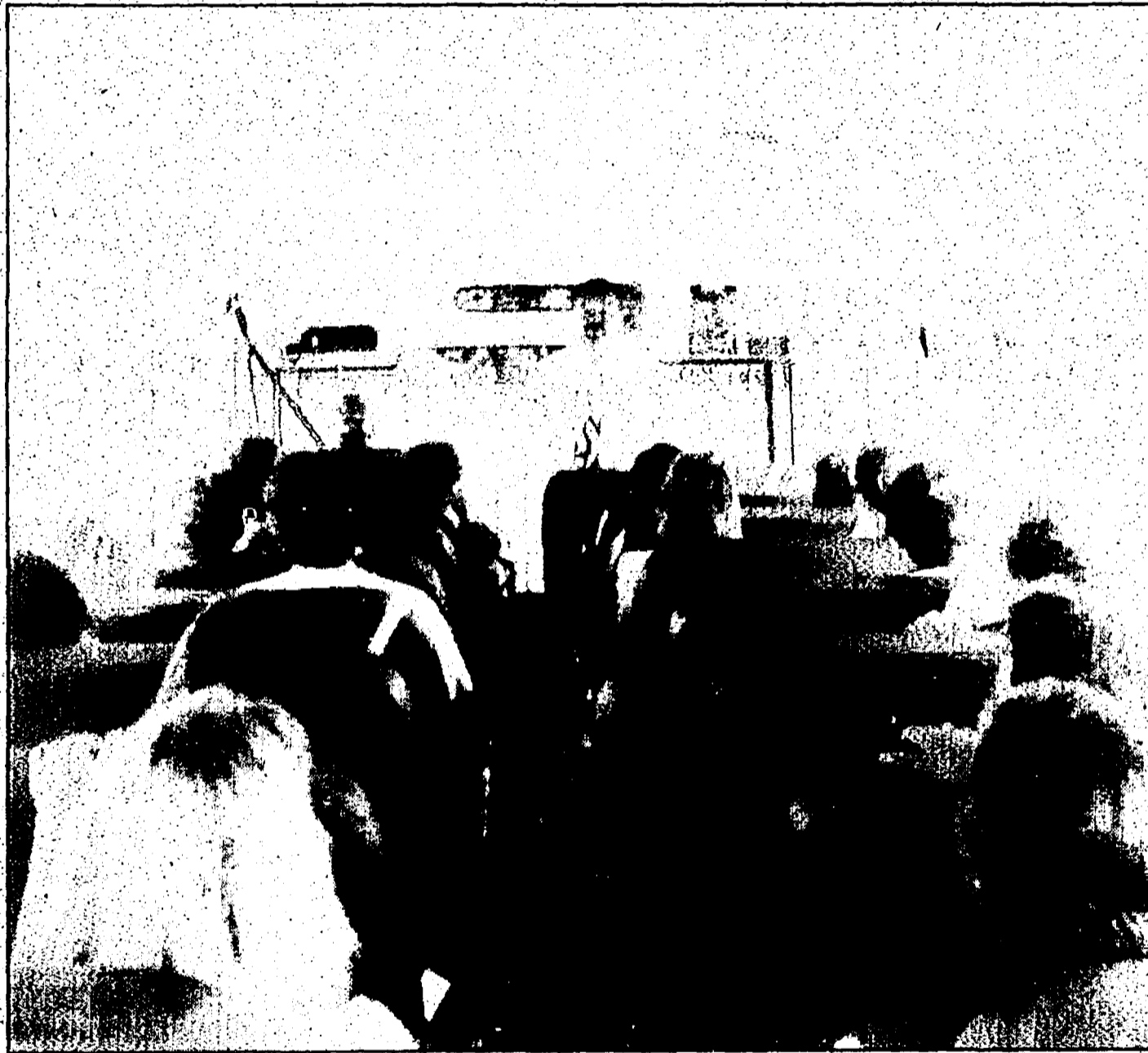
During the enrollment increases, decades ago, there were more than three children per household.

All teachers, new and returnees, are scheduled to open the new school year with two days of meetings Monday and Tuesday. Students start the new year with a half-day of classes Wednesday and Thursday. The first full day is Friday.

# Longer runway not necessarily necessary — Duggan

Building an international tradeport at Willow Run Airport is not necessarily contingent on extending the northeast runway at the airport, said Wayne County Deputy Executive Mike Duggan.

"The runway extension is one possible project of the tradeport," but is not the only project, Duggan said. "The decision of the runway is under review right now and I think there will be a very significant announcement in a few weeks," Duggan said.

Duggan said other aspects of the tradeport plan, such as improving the taxiways at the airport and making infrastructure improvements in the surrounding areas could be done without extending the runway.

The runway extension has run into strong opposition from residents in Canton Township as well as political opposition from Wayne County commissioners Thaddeus McCotter and Bruce Patterson.

McCotter represents the 10th District, which includes Plymouth, Plymouth Township and part of Livonia. Patterson represents the 11th commission District, which stretches from Canton to Huron townships and east to Wayne and Romulus.

## Opposed to tradeport

McCotter and Patterson have vowed to fight the tradeport by involving concerned citizens in their districts. The plan is to circulate petitions, contact state officials and organize community groups against the tradeport.

McCotter said he is opposed to the tradeport, with or without the runway extension. He said approving the tradeport would less-

en control of future runway extensions.

"If we get baited into creating the tradeport now, we will have no defense should the tradeport's governing board decide to extend the runway," McCotter said.

He also doubted whether a tradeport could legally be established without a runway extension.

The legislation allowing tradeports calls for a master plan that

shows transportation assets. McCotter also questioned the claim that the tradeport would create jobs, especially without the extended runway.

McCotter opposed the \$45,000 federally-funded study of the tradeport concept at a Wayne County Economic Development Committee meeting last Wednesday. The committee approved the study on a 3-2 vote. Patterson and McCotter voted against the study while Detroit commissioners Edna Bell, Robert Blackwell and Kenneth Cockrel supported the study. Commissioner Michelle Plawewski was not present. Commissioner Bernard Parker was excused from the meeting.

McCotter is chairman of that committee and Patterson is a member.

## Commission to vote

Final approval for the study must be given by the full commission. The vote is scheduled for Thursday, Aug. 31.

Duggan said he has been working closely with Canton Township Supervisor Thomas Yack and other officials to develop a revised tradeport plan.

An environmental study shows there would be a lot of noise im-

pact for residents north of the airport if the runway was extended, Duggan said.

Yack confirmed his involvement in the discussions.

"At this point, I think the concept is one that my board is thinking about," Yack said. "The fact there will not be a runway extension is a real plus for our community," Yack said.

But Yack said he was not completely sold on the tradeport plan.

"When somebody floats an idea, I want to know where it has been tried before and what success it has had. No one has really shared that with me," said Yack.

There is no guarantee that businesses will spring up at the tradeport, Yack said. The tradeport concept is based on the idea of "kind of building it and they will come," Yack said.

Thomas Fegan, of Washtenaw County and co-chair of the tradeport steering committee, said the tradeport concept was started in 1992 when General Motors closed a plant near the airport and 4,500 people lost their jobs.

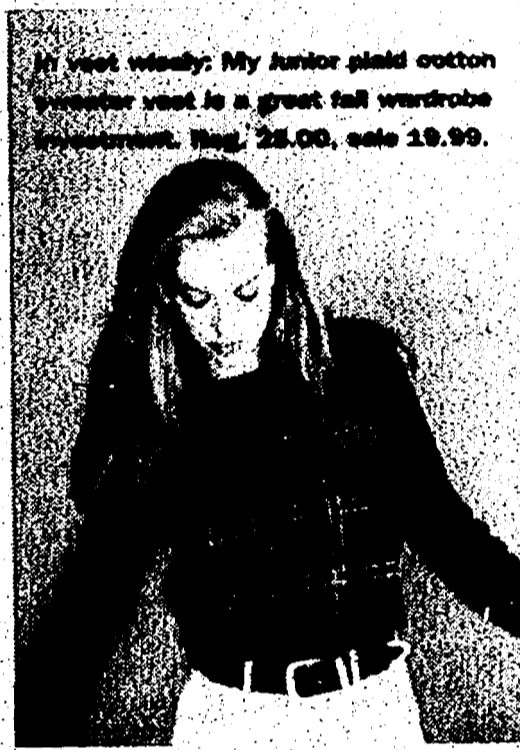

# Back-to-school info a phone call away

Parents who want back-to-school information have at least three options — two of them very easy.

First, you could drive down to the local school board office, find a parking spot, walk inside and search for the bulletin board with back-to-school information or find an available clerk to give you the desired hand-out.

Second, you can call Smart Start at 1-313-953-2001 if you live in Wayne County or 1-810-901-4750 if you live in Oakland County. This voice-mail system allows you to easily access starting dates and times for your local school district at the punch of a button. Also available on Smart Start, co-

sponsored by Jacobson's, is information on special programs for youth dealing with manners, self-esteem, and drug prevention.

Third, you can sit down at your personal computer at home and through a modem and Internet connection access Smart Start at the O&E's World Wide Web page at <http://oconline.com>. With a few clicks of the mouse, you can access school starting information on your district and detailed information on Jacobson's special programs for youth.

The Web site offers the most up-to-date example of how user-friendly technology can provide residents with practical information they need for their daily lives.

When the PC or Mac user arrives at the O&E Website, several choices await them including Smart Start. By clicking on the Smart Start icon, the user immediately goes to a Website offering information on "Magic of Manners," "New Dimensions," "Doubletalk" and "Personal Shoppers."

Magic in Manners is a free manners class for ages 5-8. The on-line text on this program tells how the world of magic is used to

convey good manners in simple terms. The five-week course goes beyond the white-glove party to include modern lessons such as how to leave a message on an answering machine, how to be a proper host when friends come over to watch videos, when to call 9-1-1, etc. A toll-free phone number (800-635-4779) is provided so residents can get information on when classes meet at their nearby Jacobson's.

New Dimensions is a series of free self-esteem workshops for girls ages 10-13. This four-week program conducted in the store covers such topics as: A Sharper Image; Techno Beauty and Make-over; Bodyline; and fashion information. A fashion show ends the series.

Doubletalk is a non-profit program that delivers drug abuse prevention information to children and their families through comedy and ventriloquism. Jacobson's has sponsored three doubletalk videos made for youngsters in elementary school, "The Rosey Ghutts Story" which demonstrates what drugs can do to the body, "Listen to the Truth" which is a collection of music videos interspersed with anima-

### Tradeport concept

The area, which includes about 6,700 acres on the border of Van Buren and Ypsilanti townships, has industrial potential because it has enough vacant land, a vacant factory and easy access to transportation, Fegan said.

In addition to air transportation, two rail lines run through the airport and I-94 and I-275 are very close, Fegan said.

A successful tradeport could create 25,000 new jobs, Fegan said.

Patterson said although he has not been directly involved in the discussions, he understands that changes in the tradeport plan may add an extension of the airport's east-west runway rather than the northeast runway. "They're trying to find a compromise and have

the opposition dissipate," Patterson said. "But I'm not lessening my opposition," he said.

Duggan denied that the new plan includes any extension of the east-west runway. "There's a reconstruction but not an extension of it," Duggan said.

The improvements would be paid for through some type of funding authority that would capture existing state or local taxes, Duggan said. However, the legislation for this funding mechanism has not been approved by the state Legislature.

The runways at Willow Run do not accommodate a fully-loaded 747. One cargo airline, Kalitta Flying Service Inc., recently moved some of its operations to Indiana. Duggan said the jets currently used at Willow Run have no trouble except for the days of

exceptional high humidity or rain. Duggan said only 5 to 10 percent of Kalitta's flights were diverted to Detroit Metropolitan Airport because of weather.

### Runway extension

The runway extension, which would jut out of the airport in a northeasterly direction, would mean that part of Ecorse Road would have to be moved. The county has already bought and demolished several houses in the Denton and Ecorse road areas so that Ecorse Road could be moved.

Duggan said he would confer with McCotter regarding the new plan but is skeptical about any swaying of Patterson.

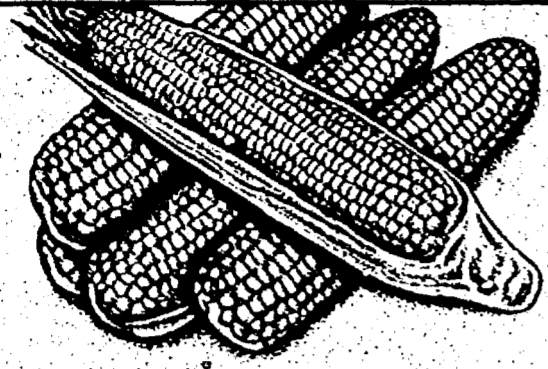

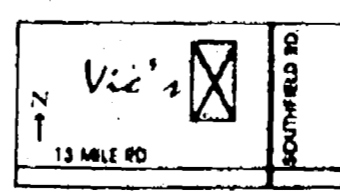
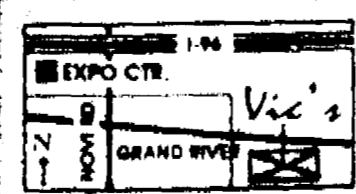

# Family discovers 'Magic in the Water' on vacation

Ashley and Josh's vacation with Dad is starting out to be a real bust.

He's divorced from Mom, and he's been too busy to see much of them, but this vacation at the lake, just the three of them, was going to be Ashley and Josh's chance to catch up on all the times they've missed being with their father. Offbeat projects highlight most anticipated fall movies

Pierce Brosnan is supposed to resurrect the James Bond franchise this fall. Big deal. What really excites me about the upcoming releases are the kooky concepts that filmmakers have been able to sell to their investors.

Shannen Daugherty hanging out at the shopping mall. Wesley Snipes and Patrick Swayze donning feather boas. Anthony Hopkins as Richard Nixon. Now you've got my attention.

So here, in no particular order, are 10 films I will be among the first in line to see. Please remember that these picks are from the same reviewer whose favorite movies this summer ranged from

Crumb to Babe: The Gallant Pig. Four Rooms. Quentin Tarantino and director pals Robert Rodriguez (Desperado), Allison Anders (Gas Food Lodging), and Alexandre Rockwell (In the Soup) join for this four-part anthology set on one very eventful New Year's Eve in a Hollywood hotel. Tim Roth plays a bellboy who ties the segments together.

Casino. Director Martin Scorsese teams again with Robert DeNiro in this highly anticipated underworld story set in Las Vegas. The story is based on a real-life gambler whose luck ran dry when he opened his own casino. Sharon Stone co-stars.

Arizona Dream. Strange as it sounds, I've never met a Johnny Depp movie I didn't like. So imagine him teamed with Jerry Lewis and Faye Dunaway in a comedy

set in Tucson and filled with heavy doses of goofiness and magical realism. Considered unreleasable when completed in 1993, it has enjoyed a healthy revival at art theaters, making a stop at the Detroit Film Theatre Sept. 29 to Oct. 1.

Clockers. Martin Scorsese, as producer, hands the director's reins over to Spike Lee. Richard Price has adapted his own novel about the inner-city drug trade, and though he gets my vote as Hollywood's most overrated (and overpaid) scribbler, everyone is raving about Delroy Lindo's performance as a wily drug dealer.

Mall Rats. Kevin Smith advances from his \$23,000 directorial debut in Clerks to this \$3 million take on life at the neighborhood shopping mall. Smith, who played Silent Bob in Clerks, appears again, but it's really bad girl Shannen Daugherty's role that has everyone guessing.

To Wong Foo, Thanks for Everything! Julie Newmar. What a title. What a concept. Wesley Snipes, John Leguizamo and Patrick Swayze don their party clothes as drag queens headed from New York to L.A. in this decidedly offbeat comedy. With the ever-idiosyncratic Bebbon Kidron (Used People) at the helm, this one could go either way.

Mighty Aphrodite. As usual, Woody Allen is being secretive about his latest project. All we know at this point is it's about marriage and stars Allen, Helena Bonham Carter, and Michael Rappaport.

Dead Presidents. The title

Broken Arrow. Hong Kong action director John Woo appears to be having the same problems at the front office that plagued his American debut, 'Hard Target.' Still this could be the one where Woo (who made 'The Killers' and 'Hardboiled') unhindered in his native country shows Hollywood how to handle firearms.

Blue in the Face. In the style

of Roger Corman, director Wayne Wang finished shooting his 'Smoke' a few days early, so he kept the cast and crew around to put an extra movie in the can. Here Madonna, Michael J. Fox, Lily Tomlin, and Roseanne walk through the doors of Harvey Keitel's Brooklyn tobacco shop.

Not without interest: Brad Pitt and Morgan Freeman hunt a serial killer in 'Seven'; The United States declares war on our northern neighbors in 'Canadian Bacon,' directed by Michael

## Chrysler sky high over Cirrus, Stratus

It should come as no surprise that Chrysler's newest cars, the Dodge Stratus and Chrysler Cirrus, are named after clouds, especially since the carmaker expects sky-high sales.

The cars have replaced the Chrysler LeBaron, Dodge Spirit and Plymouth Acclaim in the Chrysler lineup.

The Cirrus and Stratus were Chrysler's best-kept secret before their introduction. No journalist, photographer or even renowned spy photographer Jim Dunne could capture the Cirrus or Stratus on film before their Detroit debut.

Chrysler sent out cassette tapes that featured the "Mission Impossible" theme with actor Peter

Graves inviting journalists to the introduction. At a press conference, Chrysler President Robert Lutz, accompanied by Graves, orchestrated an impressive "Mission Impossible" scenario before the Cirrus and Stratus were driven through a steam cloud in a simulated warehouse

dock.

Targeted to compete in a market dominated by the Toyota Camry, Ford Taurus, Honda Accord and Mitsubishi Galant, the Cirrus and Stratus mark Chrysler's third entry into the sedan market in as many years. The vehicles will be marketed to people between 35 and 50 years old who want a mid-sized, well-equipped sedan.

"It sounds like a mission impossible to compete in this market segment and succeed," said Lutz. "I'd call it just extremely difficult. Will it be tough? You bet. But I think we can easily sell

300,000 of these cars every year."

Both the Cirrus and Stratus are 4-door sedans. All new from the inside out, the cars feature dual air bags, optional anti-lock braking systems and optional integrated child seats. The base price for the Cirrus is just over \$17,000. The Stratus' base price is \$13,965.

"Our mission three years ago was to determine what the domestic compacts were not providing and identify the root of the imports' success — quality and safety were givens," said Lutz. "Once the team knew

where we had to go, they went to work designing and engineering products that offer breakthrough design, sports-coupe performance, safety features and outstanding value."

The Cirrus and Stratus are equipped with the Neon's base 2.0-liter 16-valve SOHC engine mated to a 5-speed automatic transaxle. Also available is a 2.4-liter twin shaft DOHC with 4-speed automatic trans-axle or a top-of-the-line 2.5-liter 24-valve V6.

Both vehicles were designed by Chrysler's Large Platform Team, with advice from IndyCar driver Emmo Fittipaldi.

The Cirrus and Stratus, like the LH triplets and the LHS and New Yorker sedans, were drawn with a cab-forward design and provide a new level of interior roominess.

Both vehicles are designed to meet 1998 side-impact standards set by the U.S. government. The Cirrus and Stratus are offered with available equipment like remote keyless entry

with a panic alarm feature, a security alarm, illuminated entry, lockable folding rear seat with valet lock and hidden storage compartments.

Production of the Cirrus and Stratus are at Chrysler's Sterling Heights, Mich., Assembly Plant.

The Cirrus is the first Chrysler vehicle to bear the division's new badge. The badge, first seen as Chrysler's corporate symbol in 1924, was replaced by the Pentastar in 1962. The new badge, which will eventually replace Pentastar on all of Chrysler's models, is a seal and ribbon bearing the Chrysler name.
